ETC Awarded A2I2 Contract with ARL

ETC was recently awarded a project through its Partnership Intermediary Agreement (PIA) with the Army Research Laboratory (ARL) to assist ARL in establishing and sustaining an Army Artificial Intelligence Institute (A2I2) and to document economic and military benefits to the DoD from research performed by ARL scientists and engineers, including collaborations with industry and academia. The A2I2 task will involve the development of laboratory concepts which promote engagement with external academic and industry partners, including a Laboratory Master Plan consolidation effort.


